Summer Staycation Club!

You will need:

Card (from a delivery box) A marker pen Single hole punch Ribbons/ scraps of fabric or wool A card tube Scissors Paint (optional)

Cut out your horses head and neck using a big piece of cardboard from a box and mark on its eyes, nostril and mouth on each side. An adult will have to help cutting it out.



Cut two slits at the bottom the same width as your tube.

Use a single hole punch for the mane. If you don't have one use a pen and push it into some play dough underneath to make the hole. An adult will need to help here.



Cut 2 slits half way across at the end of your tube, and slip the tube onto the horse.

Fold a piece of ribbon/ fabric or wool in half and push the loop through. Once your loop is through, pull your tail end of the ribbon etc through the loop and pull tight. Repeat on all the holes to make the mane.
