
Make a Fox Mask

Have you ever seen a fox? They mainly come out at night but can be spotted in the daytime too. Did you know that they are a member of the dog family and baby foxes are called cubs? Learn how to make a fox mask of your own using a paper plate.





A paper plate Scissors A glue stick or PVA Sellotape Orange paint, paper or felt tips Brown and Black felt tip Paintbrush and water pot A hole punch and string or a stick





Summer Staycation Club!

Cut your paper plate in half. On one of the halves, cut out two triangles for ears.





Colour in a black nose on the half a plate you cut the ears from and stick on with the ears, once they are dry. Add in two white triangles in the ears from the plate. Draw in two shapes on the half plate to make a fox shaped head and draw in some eyes, carefully cut them out with some help from an adult.



Add in some details using the brown felt tip to make your fox look soft. You can also draw round the eyes to make them stand out. Paint, colour or collage orange colour onto the mask, don't forget to paint the ears.



Colour in some black on the scrap plate, cut out and make whiskers. Then to wear, hole punch the sides and attach string or stick a stick to the back to make a hand held mask!
