Elsecar Reservoir was the main attraction for residents visiting the village in the 1920's for their annual holiday. Did you know that the reservoir has fish in it called Carp? Have a go at creating your own fishing game and see what you can catch.

You will need:

A small, empty box or a paper Coloured paper and small pieces of coloured card Glue stick Scissors Paper straws or sticks for the fishing rod String Two small magnets

Paper Clips

Sellotape





Decorate your box or bowl in an under the water theme using coloured paper and collage.



Create your fish with the colourful card. You can also put old boots in there, jellyfish, treasure and anything else you want to fish.



Attach a paper clip to each item. You can stick them on the back or slot on to look like fins.



Tie string to the end of the straw and attach the magnet to the bottom of the string with tape. Hide the magnet with some card if you like.



Why not make up some score cards with the colourful paper. You can put how many things to fish and who will be the fastest.



Time to play! Hold your fishing rod over the water and see what you catch first.
