## Sabre-Tooth Tiger Chase

Sabre-tooth tigers were one of the great carnivores of the ice age but went extinct around 12,000 years ago. Although they are commonly called tigers they were more closely related to lions, and hunted and lived in packs in the same way modern lions do today. You will need:

Paint, collage materials or felt tips A paper plate Glue stick Thin white card White tissue paper A stapler Straws Scissors



Cut out the middle of your paper plate to look like this, saving the two pieces from the eye area for ears. Use felts, paint or collage to decorate the plate and ears..



Cut a zig-zag pattern into some white tissue paper and use thin white card to make two sabre teeth.



Use a glue stick to stick on your tissue paper and staple on your sabre teeth



Cut two short straws for each side and staple into place.





Cut a slit upwards from the bottom, middle of each ear, fold over the end as above and staple in place to make a 3D ear. Staple on some elastic.
