Barnsley Museums Makes: Milk Carton Elmer



Create your own mini Elmer using a milk carton and tissue paper. Why not save future bottles and create a herd of Elmers!

You will need:

An empty milk carton, any size A pen to mark where to cut Tissue paper in a variety of colours Scissors PVA glue Glue brush White paper and pen for eyes or googly eyes Sellotape



Mark out where you need to cut the carton using a pen (permanent works best).



Carefully cut along the handle line to make the trunk and along main carton for legs and body.



Cut tissue paper into lots of squares.



Stick on the squares with PVA, overlapping the colours slightly looks effective too.



Cut ear shapes out of card or leftover milk bottle. Fold down at ends and stick on with tape.



Draw some eyes, cut and stick them on or use googly eyes and you have a mini Elmer!
