Barnsley Museums Makes: Handprint Elephant



Sensory seeking children will love the feel of the paint on their hands. If a child doesn't like sensory input then simply draw around their hand, cut it out and let them decorate it as they like!

You will need:

Black and white (or grey) poster paint **Paintbrush** White paper Black paper Black pen Googly eyes



Gather your materials and mix the black and white paint to make grey.



Paint your hand grey. Make sure to cover it all!



Print the hand onto white paper. The four fingers will become legs and the thumb a trunk.



As the paint is drying, cut out an ear shape from black paper.



Once the paint is dry stick the ear down. Stick or draw on the googly eye.



Using a black pen, draw feet, a tail and any other detail. Why not try making an Elmer Parade with lots of elephants painted in bright colours and patterns.
