A4 card Pens Scissors Glue Ribbon (optional)




Have you ever wanted to be an astronaut and explore space? Why not make your own astronaut's helmet and blast off on an adventure with our Imaginarium space adventure.



Use a medium size plate to draw around leaving tabs at either side to attach to a card band or to attach ribbon.

Cut a face panel in after judging where this would be most comfortable for the wearer.



Decorate with a logo, buttons, ear pieces, oxygen pipe and an aerial as required.



Depending on your preference either measure your child's head and make a band about 4cm wide (This allows the child to 'wear' the helmet without it enclosing their head.) or cut ribbon long enough to attach to the tabs and tie behind your child's head.
