Did you know that many rare species of birds make Worsbrough Mill Country Park their home? Why not make your own Tweety Pie Bird Biscuits?



Cream the margarine and sugar in a bowl



Mix in the flour and oats



4oz / 116g porridge oats 3oz / 61g margarine 2oz / 58g sugar 1oz / 34g self-raising flour Things to decorate your owl biscuits with





Turn carefully onto your surface and roll to 1 cm thick. Use a circle cutter to cut out.



Bake on a greased baking sheet in the oven at 180c for 20 minutes



Decorate your biscuits to look like little birds. Here we've used melted chocolate, icing and sultanas
