1. **HEY!** DO YOU WANT TO HAVE A GO AT MAKING YOUR OWN WHIRLY GIG?

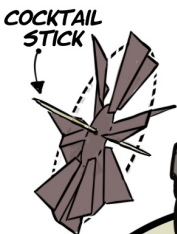
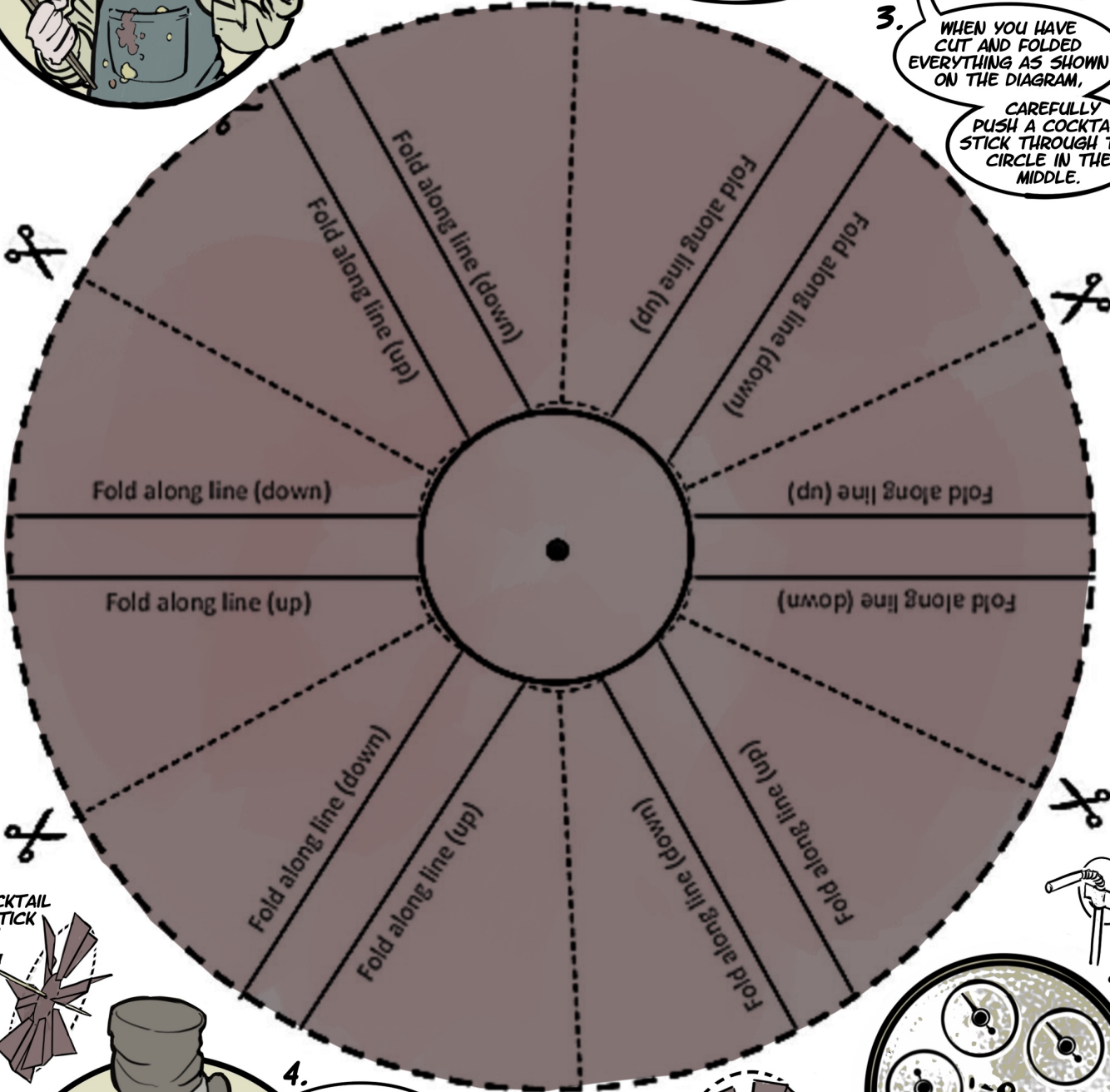
OKAY, SO YOU WILL NEED:

A WAY TO COPY OR PRINT OUT THE DIAGRAM BELOW.
PLASTERCINE/STICKY TAPE.
THIN CARD.
BENDY STRAWS.
COCKTAIL STICKS.

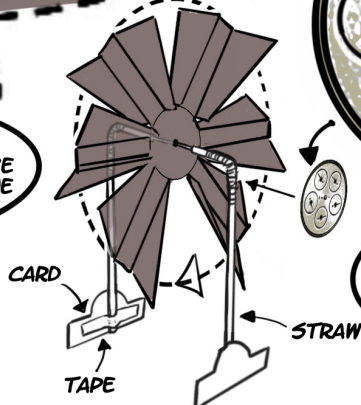


2. FIRST, PRINT OUT THE DIAGRAM BELOW, (YOU COULD EVEN STICK IT TO SOME THIN CARD) THEN CAREFULLY CUT OUT THE DISK AND CUT ALONG THE DOTTED LINES

3. WHEN YOU HAVE CUT AND FOLDED EVERYTHING AS SHOWN ON THE DIAGRAM, CAREFULLY PUSH A COCKTAIL STICK THROUGH THE CIRCLE IN THE MIDDLE.



4. SLIDE THE SHORT END OF A BENDY STRAW OVER EACH END OF THE COCKTAIL STICK. THEN, FIX THE OTHER END OF EACH STRAW TO A PIECE OF CARD WITH PLASTERCINE OR STICKY TAPE, SO THEY STAND UPRIGHT. YOUR ANEMOMETER SHOULD NOW SPIN FREELY.



5. FINALLY, CUT OUT AND STICK THIS DIAL TO THE CENTRE OF YOUR ANEMOMETER OR DESIGN YOUR OWN.
